

SUPREMA's SIT&GO LEADERBOARD

1. INITIAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1. The purpose of these regulations is to establish the rules and guidelines for participation in the Sit&Go leaderboard run by Suprema Gaming & CO, a company registered with the CNPJ under No. 37.684.385/0001-63, known as "SUPREMA UNION".
- 1.2. The Leaderboard is aimed at individuals over 18 (eighteen) years old and who are linked to a Club associated with Suprema Union's participating Unions and will be governed by the clauses and provisions of these regulations.
The event is of a recreational and sporting nature, in accordance with article 3, item II of Law 5768/71 and article 30 of Decree 70.951/72. Participation is voluntary and does not imply any burden of any kind for registered Participants or for the Participants who win the prize at the end, except for tax obligations.
- 1.3. Participants should check the official website page for information on the leaderboard.
- 1.4. The leaderboard will happen weekly, starting at 12:00 a.m. every Monday and ending at 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, resetting at the beginning of the following week, Brasilia official time (GMT-3), with no set end date. The organizer reserves the right to change the schedule without prior notice if deemed necessary for the smooth running of the event.
- 1.5. The Sit&Go Leaderboard is exclusive to accounts verified by SecurityPKR.

2. RESCHEDULING AND/OR CANCELLATION OF TOURNAMENTS (SIT&GO):

- 2.1. If for any reason the tournament cannot be carried out as planned, due to technical problems, unauthorized interventions, fraud or other causes that are outside the control of the organization, including but not limited to events of force majeure, phenomena of nature, which may in any way corrupt or affect the administration, safety, suitability, integrity or the proper conduct of this tournament, the organization reserves the right, at its discretion, to cancel, terminate, reschedule or suspend, for as long as it deems necessary, the tournament, without the obligation to reimburse or compensate, in any way, any competitor, with the exception of the return of registration fees for competitors already registered.
- 2.2. In the event of tournament cancellation, only those who are unequivocally registered for the cancelled tournament up to the date of cancellation will be considered clients of the organizer, and effectively competitors in the event.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1. All individuals over the age of eighteen (18) who register correctly and completely on the SUPREMA UNION App may take part in the series. They must also be affiliated with a poker club that is associated with SUPREMA UNION and its participating unions. Registration must be done with truthful and up-to-date information to guarantee eligibility and participation in the series. It is important to note that any attempt to register with false or incomplete data will result in the automatic disqualification of the participant. Joining the program is subject to the rules and regulations established by SUPREMA UNION and the affiliated poker clubs, which must be strictly followed to ensure a fair and transparent experience for all involved.
- 3.2. The Participant's membership in the series is subject to the terms and conditions of these Regulations and the rules set out on the SUPREMA UNION portal <https://supremapoker.com.br/regulamento-geral/> (Community Rules, Brand Rules, General Regulations and Terms and Conditions), which shall be deemed to have been accepted by the Participant when registering and participating in the events that make up the leaderboard.
- 3.3. The Participant is responsible for keeping their registration details up to date, especially their name, your personal identification number, e-mail address, address and contact telephone numbers. SUPREMA UNION shall not be held liable for any damage or loss resulting from incorrect information provided by the Participant.

4. SUPREMA POKER APP ACCOUNT

- 4.1. Each Participant can be linked to his or her player ID and club, and is non-transferable. Under no circumstances will the scores and possible prizes for the event be transferred to third parties. If the player plays for more than one club, their scores and possible prizes will be separated by the club in which they participated in any tournament, counting the points independently.
- 4.2. The information contained in the Account on the SUPREMA UNION App, Access Password, ID, Nick name, among others, is personal, non-transferable and of the exclusive knowledge of the Participant, and it is their duty to keep it strictly confidential, not disclosing it, providing it or sharing it in any way or form, including in applications and electronic password storage sites. Except in cases of proven fraud, damages arising from improper use or access to such information by third parties are the sole responsibility of the Participant.
- 4.3. The Leaderboard will feature exclusive scoring table for verified players. To take part in the leaderboard's for verified accounts, participants must register and request account verification through the following website: <https://security.supremapoker.com.br/>.

5. SCORING CRITERIA FOR SIT&GO LEADERBOARDS:

- 5.1. Participants will be scored according to the aforementioned score chart. Only competitors who finish within the scoring range officially published by the organization will receive points.
- 5.2. The LEADERBOARD will consist of Low and Middle rankings, with table levels detailed below.
- 5.3. The LEADERBOARD will have 2 (two) different **Rankings**, in which players can participate in all of them, but their scores are independent (adding up each ranking score individually, points in LOW Sit&Go tournaments are added to the LOW ranking, in the MEDIUM Sit&Go tournaments to the MEDIUM ranking):
 - 5.3.1. **LOW RANKING** – Will consist of tables **levels 1, 2, 3 and 4**, in which tables level 1 are named **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO I e 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO I**, level 2 tables **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG II and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG II**, level 3 tables **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG III and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG III**, level 4 tables **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG IV and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG IV**, the weekly raking will be based on the scores shown below, with the top 15 finishers will be awarded prizes according to the points distribution chart below.
 - 5.3.2. **MEDIUM RANKING** – Will consist of tables **levels 5, 6, and 7**, in which tables level 5 are named **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG V and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG V**, level 6 tables **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG VI and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG VI**, level 7 tables **6-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG VII and 9-MAX HYPER/TURBO/REG VII**, the weekly raking will be based on the scores shown below, with the top 15 finishers will be awarded prizes according to the points distribution chart below.
- 5.4. Each participant's score will be linked to their player ID and club, and is non-transferable. Under no circumstances will the Ranking points be transferred to third parties. If the player plays for more than one club, their scores will be separated by the club in which they participated in any tournament, counting the points independently, as the multiplication factor.
The participant can play for any of the clubs associated with the participating unions, which will have their score linked to their player ID.
- 5.5. To take part in the leaderboard's for verified accounts, participants must register and request account verification through the following website <https://security.supremapoker.com.br/>.

6. RANKING POINTS:

6.1. Leaderboard Scoring System:

The Sit&Go leaderboard scoring system consists of an exclusive score for 6-max tables and another score for 9-max tables. Players score progressively from last place to 1st place in the Sit&Go tournament.

The basepoints for the table's levels follow these formats: level 1 is 0,20, level 2 is 0,40, level 3 is 1,00, level 4 is 2,00, level 5 is 4,00, level 6 is 6,00 and level 7 is 10,00. These basepoints are multiplied by the multiplier for each position in the 6-MAX and 9-MAX table rankings, explained below:

6.4. Players who break and/or violate Suprema's fair play rules will be banned and immediately excluded from the Ranking, losing all their scores. There is no possibility of transferring scores to another ID. Link to fair play rules available in item 3.2 of these regulations.

6.5. The ranking will be updated periodically after the end of each event, and may be delayed by up to one working day.

6.6. At the end of all Events and their respective Rankings, if there is a draw in the score between two or more players, the following tie-breaking criteria will be followed:

- a. Number of wins (1st place) in Sit&Go tournaments;
- b. Number of second places in Sit&Go tournaments;
- c. Number of third places in Sit&Go tournaments, and so on.

7. THE AWARDS

7.1. The SIT&Go LEADERBOARD will distribute the following prizes in the weekly rankings:

7.1.1. 2K (BRL) in prizes – distributed to the top 15 finishers in the **LOW ranking (levels 1, 2, 3 and 4)**.

- 1st place: 400,00
- 2nd place: 250,00
- 3rd place: 200,00
- 4th place: 150,00
- 5th place: 125,00
- 6th to 10th place: 100,00
- 11th to 15th place: 75,00

7.1.2. 3K (BRL) in prizes – distributed to the top 15 finishers in the **MEDIUM ranking (levels 5, 6 and 7)**.

- 1st place: 600,00
- 2nd place: 400,00
- 3rd place: 300,00
- 4th place: 250,00
- 5th place: 200,00
- 6th to 10th place: 150,00
- 11th to 15th place: 100,00

7.2. The prize described in Item 7.1 will be linked to the player's account ID.

7.3. The winner of one of the prizes described in Item 7.1. must prove that they are the holder of the winning account, without prejudice to, if necessary, presenting personal documents for registration purposes. By participating in the Event, the Player consents to the sharing of their personal data, and is aware that the data collected will be stored for a minimum period of ten years.

7.4. Once the series has been completed and all the winners have been named, the winning player will receive the chips for their ranking prize via the club they are a member of.

- 7.5. The prize in chips is non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 7.6. Participants may play for any of the clubs associated with the participating unions.
- 7.7. The prizes described in item 7.1. will be delivered to the winner within **30 working days** of the announcement of the winners, or within a maximum of 30 (thirty) days from the date of recognition of the winner.

8. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 8.1. All SIT&GO tournaments that include the **Sit&Go LEADERBOARD**, will have an extra 2% fee to feed the event, such as prizes and promotions during the course of the event.
- 8.2. To verify an account, the participant must complete their registration with valid information on the following website. The verification process may take up to 72 hours (3 business days, excluding weekends and holidays) so that Suprema can confirm all submitted data and validate the account. - 8.3. SUPREMA UNION reserves the right to invalidate the Points in the Participant's Account if it becomes aware that all the obligations contained in the rules of any tournament participating in the Sit&Go leaderboard held by SUPREMA UNION have not been met.
- 8.4. Any doubts, divergences or situations not provided for in the regulations will be judged and decided by SUPREMA UNION in a sovereign and unappealable manner.
- 8.5. SUPREMA UNION cannot be held responsible for any information sent in error, incomplete, incorrect, invalid or inaccurate which makes it impossible to contact them and/or deliver the prizes. The participant expressly acknowledges and accepts that SUPREMA UNION cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss arising from participation in this Event or from the eventual acceptance of the prize.
- 8.6. SUPREMA UNION shall not be held liable for any technical transmission failure, Internet access problems or any unforeseeable event or force majeure that may prevent the user from participating in any of the events.
- 8.7. SUPREMA UNION shall not be considered to be in default or non-compliance with any of its obligations under these Regulations if the reason for non-compliance is due to unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure, as established by the Brazilian Civil Code (Law no. 10.406/2002).
- 8.8. The ranking is not linked to any other SUPREMA UNION series/special events in force during its term and, therefore, its points are not cumulative.
- 8.9. Any operational aspects, scoring, prizes and other conditions of the series may be altered during the course of the event, with prior notice from SUPREMA UNION.
